#### □ Set Up Your <u>myLSUA</u> Account

Visit <u>Isua.it/accountsetup</u>, enter your Social Security Number, and complete the prompts. Agree to LSUA policies unless you are an LSUE, high school, UA CenLA student or faculty/staff member. Submit to receive your LSUA username and email. Need help? Visit <u>Isua.it/</u> <u>passwordreset</u>.

#### **Complete Your Online Orientation Course**

Complete the Online Onboarding Course in <u>Moodle</u> to learn about your online classroom. Self-enroll by searching for "Online Student Onboarding" and clicking Enroll Me.
